In weekly sessions, we work with your teen to:

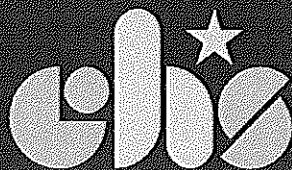
- Develop and reach goals
