The Why Try program is created to provide simple, hands-on solutions for dropout prevention, violence prevention, truancy reduction, and increased academic success. The prevention program is designed to enhance the development of personal and social skills.

The Why-Try Curriculum is a strength-based approach to help youths overcome challenges they may face. This curriculum is based on showing youth that making good decisions while sometimes can be difficult, do so will result in more opportunities, freedom and self-respect.
